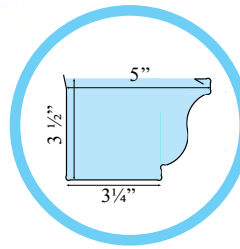
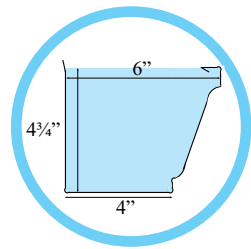

Standard 5" gutter holds 1.2 gallons per foot

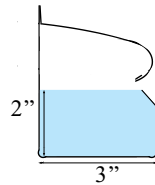


Standard 6" gutter holds 2.0 gallons per foot



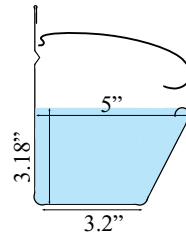
Gutter Helmet installs over your existing, full-size gutters.

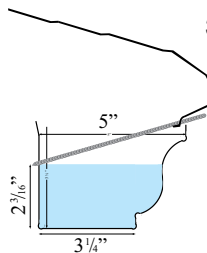
1. All-in-one system

- Reduced capacity requiring up to twice as many downspouts
- Replaces existing, functional gutters
- Minor damage requires expensive replacement
- May not meet code requirements in all cities
- Vertical openings that can clog
- Shingle overhang reduces surface tension area
- No ribs or texture to slow water flow



2. Gutter combos

- Replaces existing, functional gutters
- Directs water towards fascia boards, promoting rot
- Vertical openings that can clog
- Shingle overhang reduces surface tension area
- No ribs or texture to slow water flow



3. Knockoffs

- Plastic bracket
- Smooth panel has reduced water handling capacity vs. textured
- Heavier panel puts additional weight and stress on gutters
- Bracket screws go through the back of the gutter, promoting water damage including fascia and rafter rot (Cost for replacing one rafter ~ \$10,000)
